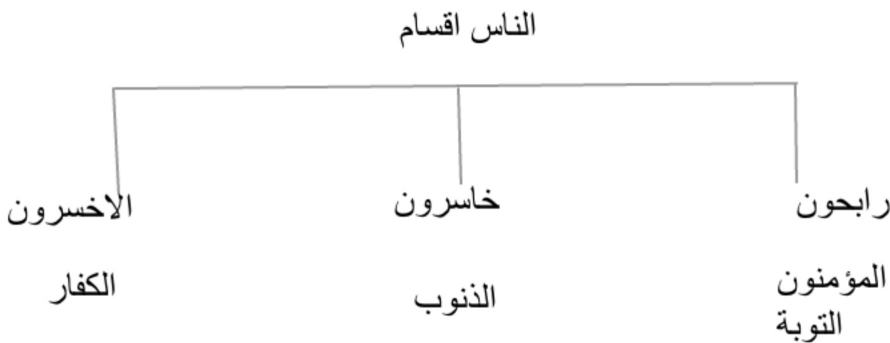
Allah gave

you your nafs as a trust. The successful one is he who took care of his heart, and made himself a winner. The disbeliever, the one who doesn't believe in the Day of Judgement, loses himself and his family in the hellfire. The one who corrupted himself, is lost.

The more you believe, the more safe you are. The messengers call the people to the faith, but they lose the opportunity. The one who doesn't believe in the akhirah is the biggest loser on the Day of Judgement, losing himself and his family. Your value is your faith. The disbeliever loses everything, because he loses his faith. He loses even the tiny bit of faith, which is part of the fitrah. If you want to save yourself and your family, you must have belief.

People are different groups.



The successful ones are those who believe, and repent. With forgiveness, you will be able to do all the good deeds.

The losers will be lost depending upon their sins. The disbelievers are the greatest losers. They will not have any share of the hereafter. The losers can also be believers who sin, while the kuffar will have no saving grace at all. They will be punished in dunya too. Belief in the akhirah is a strong feeling, even though it is the unseen.

Benefits from the ayah

- The consequence of their disbelief is that they will have the worst punishment on the Day of Judgement.
- The disbelievers will have no share of the hereafter, they will remain in the hellfire for eternity.
- This ayah is an affirmation of the hereafter, that it surely

- The one who doesn't believe in the Day of Judgement is the greatest loser.
- Those who believe in the Day of Judgement, but are sinners, and committed the major sins, will not remain in the hellfire for eternity; this refutes the claim of the extremists.
- The Qura'an accurately describes the condition of the disbelievers on the Day of Judgement.

The Qura'an was revealed upon the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم, and he received it. The word تلقى is as if the Qura'an slid to the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم, and he had to take it. When the revelation came to the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم, beads of sweat would appear on his brow, and if he was riding on an animal, it would sit down. The words of Allah are so heavy.

The Qura'an is from Allah, so close to Him, which we see from the words من لدن.

Allah is the Most Wise, and the All-Knower. He makes everything happen at the perfect time and place, and He is aware of the hidden matters. Nothing is random, everything is in its perfect place. The name of Allah الحكيم comes before العليم; Allah knows the secrets of all the matters, so He places them in their perfect places. Every piece of the puzzle is in its correct place.

The Qura'an gives wisdom and knowledge, it is a shortcut to the route of experience. Its benefits are solely for the believers.

- The Qura'an is from Allah.
- The one who takes the Qura'an will get wisdom and knowledge
- The Qura'an affirms the prophethood and the message.
- The wisdom of Allah is based upon His knowledge.

Musa عليه السلام was the best of the messengers of the Bani Israeel. Allah favoured Musa عليه السلام with 9 clear signs. But they rejected these signs. Musa received these signs when he was lost in the cold desert at night. He saw a fire from far away, and that was the beginning.
